Isabella Proeller is Professor and holds the Chair for Public and Nonprofit Management at the University of Potsdam. She started her education with studies at the university of St. Gallen in Switzerland and the Ecole Supérieur de Commerce de Paris (ESCP) in France, and completed her basic education with masters degrees in Business Administration and in Law from the University of St. Gallen in Switzerland. She then worked as research associate at the Institute of Public Services and Tourism at the University, where she in 2002 became deputy director. Prof. Proeller held a scholarship from the Swiss National Research Fund and was visiting scholar at the Harris School of Public Policy at the University of Chicago in the U.S. Prof. Proeller is a member of the steering committee of the European Group of Public Administration (EGPA) and serves in the editorial board or even as (Co-)editor of several journals, she is Deputy Editor of the International Review of Administrative Science. Her research focus is on strategic management in public administration, administrative reform, performance management as well international comparative public management.
