

**TO ADHERE AS A GOVERNMENTAL INTERNATIONAL  
ORGANIZATION**

This category of membership applies to any Governmental International Organization established by a treaty and comprised, at least in part, of Member States of the Institute.

The Governmental International Organization Member is represented on the Council of Administration by its representative who has a seat with the right to vote and participates directly in the orientation of the Institute's objectives and activities. The Council of Administration elects the President, the Vice-Presidents and the Members of the Executive Committee.

The Organization sends an official letter to IIAS requesting membership. The IIAS forwards the request to the Executive Committee of the Institute which puts forward the candidacy to the Council of Administration. To be approved as a member of the Institute, the Organization must agree to comply with the Statutes of IIAS.

The annual subscription amounts to 2.708,00 Euros minimum for a governmental **regional** organization and 8.124,00 Euros minimum for a governmental **international** organization.
